

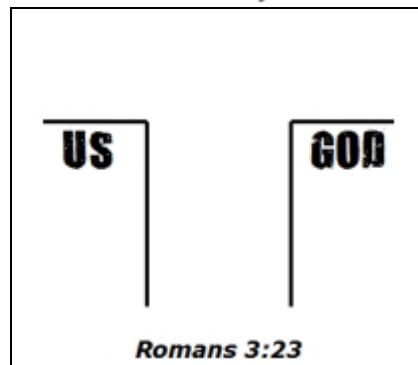
# ALL HAVE SINNED

## THE JESUS BRIDGE - WEEK 2 (27Aug-2Sep)

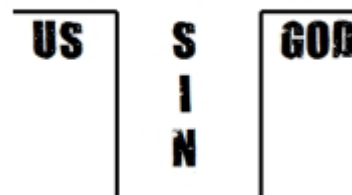
- 1 Deut 32:4 - **God** is the Rock, his works are perfect, he **does no wrong**.
- 2 Rom 3:23 - For **all have sinned** and fall short of the glory of God
- 3 Rom 6:23 - For the wages of **sin is death**
- 4 Rom 5:08 - BUT God demonstrates his love for us in this: while we were still sinners **Christ died for us**.
- 5 Rom 10:9 - That if you confess with your mouth. "**Jesus is Lord**," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.



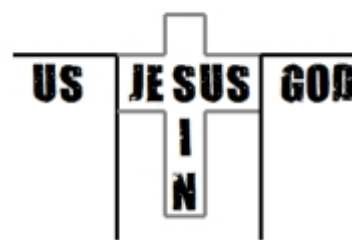

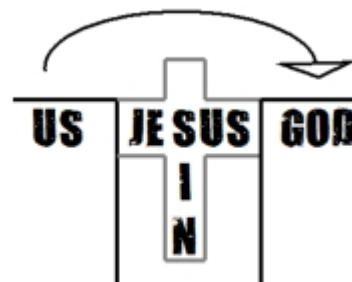

## TREK READING NOTES

### TREK DAY 1 >> Read Romans 1:21-23

- > What have people failed to do to God?
- > What have people put in the place of God?
- > What things do you put in the place of God?

Say sorry to God for failing to give thanks to him.

### TREK DAY 2 >> Read Romans 3:10-18

- > What words does this passage use to describe us?
- > Is there anyone good?

Thank God that Jesus is the one person who is good. Thank God that Jesus did what we couldn't.

### TREK DAY 3 >> Read Romans 3:23

Imagine swimming non-stop to from Australia to New Zealand. How far do you think you could get? Even the best swimmers would fall a long way short of NZ! Today's Bible passage shows that sin is when we fall short of God's glory.

- > Re-write this verse in your own words...

Pray that your friends would see that they have sinned and need Jesus.

### TREK DAY 4 >> Prayer & Praise

Spend time reading over each of this week's passages. Pray that God would help you to see yourself clearly. Thank God for Jesus.

### TREK DAY 5 >> Memorise & Practise

Practise drawing steps 1 & 2, memorise verses 1 & 2, pray for your friends

## STUDY FOR SUNDAY

**KICK OFF** – What evidence can you see of sin in our world?

**Pray & Read:** Romans 1:21-23

- > How have people treated God?
- > Write a definition of 'sin' based on these verses...
- > What things do you put in the place of God?

**Read:** Romans 3:23

- > How many people have sinned?
- > What examples can you think of to try and illustrate this point? (look @ day 3)

**Practise** drawing steps 1 & 2. Work on memorising the first 2 verses.
